Description

FP160 is a steel encased closer device for combustible pipes of up to 200 mm. Available in various lengths, it is the perfect solution for angled pipes. FP160 provides service interigty of up to 4 hours, dependant on substrate. It may be used directly in solid or flexible substrates, or within FB750 coated batts. Additional clips may be required in floors slabs.

Usage / Purpose

Used to seal combustible pipes as they pass through fire compartment walls and floors. When exposed to fire, the intumescent lining within the metal sleeve expands and fills the space left by the heat softened pipe thus reinstating the fire compartment line.

The product is suitable for retrofit or maybe installed prior to service installation. When used as a multibox or cable closer, foam smoke seals should be requested.




Installation

- Pull open FP160 and fit around pipe, cable or duct.
- Push FP160 through compartment wall ensuring equal overhang to each side.
- Close FP160.
- Seal in place using FS702 sealant in gaps up to 20 mm. Larger openings may be sealed with FB750.
- Annular spaces up to 60 mm may be packed using a minimum 60 mm depth of 64 kg rock mineral wool plus 3 mm of FS 702 to provide a smoke seal.
- Length of sleeve is relative to the depth of wall and should be specified when placing order.




FP160 Sleeve pipe penetration in dry lined wall


